And just like my transformative relationship with Borelli, without a doubt, the absolute best part of my job has been bonding with my students, growing relationships that have evolved into deeply close and lasting friendships. After ushering my students through high school, I've had the joy and privilege of having watched them graduate college, attended their professional performances, witnessed their marriages, have seen many begin their own families. I am even the proud Godmother to a beautiful daughter of a former student of mine. Together, we have spent countless hours on the phone, shared innumerable meals, spent hours having reverent and awe inspiring conversations, consumed a gazillion matcha lattes together, and laughed enough laughs and shed enough tears to last a lifetime. In other words, I have experienced priceless belovedness.

I have loved teaching. I have loved directing. I love my students.

Now, I am ready to embark on the next chapter of my life.
